Description:

Re-purpose old, damaged books and create a meaningful, beautiful and one-of-a-kind piece of art.

Taking Zentangle Essentials, or having Zentangle experience, prior to taking this class is highly recommended so you will understand the basic concept, strokes and techniques, although it's not required.

Items you will need:

✦ A page out of an old book. (Any book is good. Could be music, recipe book, something with some words on it.) Here are some pages, if you need one (same book as in the picture): [Pg.152](#), [Pg.153](#), [Pg.210](#), [Pg.211](#), [Pg.226](#), [Pg.227](#)

✦ Pens: Microns or other fine liners, in black, and other colors.

✦ Gel pens, markers and/or colored pencils

✦ For shading: pencil, (graphite – regular No.2 is great)

✦ For highlighting: white gel pen, white chalk, charcoal, or colored pencil.

✦ Tortillion or stump (Or maybe cotton swab, to blend.)

✦ Anything else you wish to have handy for whatever may strike you, creatively.

I will share some suggested tangles and will provide step-outs. You can do any tangles you want though. You can see in the picture the types of tangles I have used in the past.
