

Chop Shop Class

Description:

What's a chop, you ask? From Wikipedia: "... in an East and Southeast Asian context, [a chop] is a general name for printing stamps and impressions thereof which are used in lieu of signatures in personal documents, office paperwork, contracts, art, or any item requiring acknowledgement or authorship."

Step 7 in the Zentangle Method, is initial and sign. This is where those that have created a chop will use it. So you know – it's ok if you don't you can just initial.
